EGHC staff from all four offices were on-hand to conduct continuous personal tours of the remodeled facility. A total of 110 visitors from the community as a whole enjoyed the festivities and refreshments.



Several years in the planning, this expansion and face-lift added 6 fully equipped exams rooms, space for expanded medical services, a comfortably larger waiting room and more amenities for patients. Now the largest physician's office in the area, this building project surpassed in scale anything EGHC had done to date, and all for the benefit of patients and the community. It's bigger, brighter and more comfortable.

A larger office and increased need in the community of course requires more staff. So, during this building project EGHC also expanded the medical staff. Now boasting 4 Board Certified Family Practice doctors; Dr. M. I. Jamal, Dr. Traceyan Mendez, Dr. John Murimi, Dr. Debra Mataosky as well as Family Nurse Practitioner, Brenda Thompson. These new medical providers are excited to become an active part of our medical community.

The construction took 3 months to complete and included all parts of the office. Almost 1,000 square feet was added to the front of the building, new paint inside and out, new carpet, new furniture and equipment.

So that no one lost access to their healthcare, the office remained open during the construction. While this was a challenge for the construction crew and the office staff, the end result is an obvious accomplishment and upgrade for all of Swainsboro's medical community.
